I. CALL TO ORDER; ROLL CALL; INTRODUCTION OF VISITORS

Chairman Cowan called the meeting to order at 2:03 pm.

II. SPECIAL PRESENTATION

III. Q & A with Mr. Cooley

Following Mr. Cooley's presentation, members asked a variety of questions. Ms. Deering inquired about the rehabilitation option, as listed in AB 1826 ("....pursue the construction of a state capitol building annex or the restoration, rehabilitation, renovation, or reconstruction of the existing State Capitol Building Annex"). Ms. Peper indicated that she hopes the final decision will include a tree management plan. Mr. Cooley stated that he wants to "invigorate the park."

Ms. Polanco explained that the style of the current Annex reflects an important time in history and it should be utilized in the telling of the story of California's "People's House."

Ms. Benoit circulated copies of a letter from Gretchen Steinberg, President of Sacramento Modern (SacMod), a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving modern art, architecture, and design in the Sacramento region. Ms. Steinberg asked that the letter be distributed at the meeting; in it, she requested assurances that:

- 1. The evaluation of all options would utilize the California Historical Building Code;
- 2. The rehabilitation option would utilize the Secretary of the Interior's Standards; and,
- 3. The significant cultural landscape and potentially significant archeological sites of Capitol Park be respected.

IV. Commission Discussion

Following Mr. Cooley's presentation and departure, members continued their discussion. Ms. Polanco asked whether there would be five separate CEQA reports or just one (swing space, visitor center, West Wing modifications, Annex, parking)? She also reflected on the importance of the adaptive reuse/rehabilitation option. Chair Cowan reiterated the need of the Legislature to review all of the options, not just the construction option.
